

Lakeview Patrons,

Thank you for your interest in the 2020 Lakeview Amateur.

The rotation Saturday will be Peak - Mountain; Sunday, Mountain - Lake.

Signing up is easy, as there are 4 divisions: Championship, Men's, Senior, and Super Senior.

Championship Division- Open to any age. Players must play from the **Blue Tee**.

Men's Division- Open to any age. Players must play from the **White Tee**.

Senior Division- Open to anyone 55 and older. Players must play from the **Gold Tee**.

Super Senior Division- Open to anyone 70 and older. Players must play from the **Red Tee**.

After Saturday's 1st Round of competition, each division will be flighted according to score.

The lowest scores in each division will qualify for the Championship Flight.

All other competitors (*in each respective division*) will then be separated into the 1st Flight, 2nd Flight, etc.

The # of players paid in each flight will depend on the total # of players in each division.

There will be an OPTIONAL \$KINS game both days (\$10 per day)

All participants in the 2020 Lakeview Amateur must abide by the following Rules and Policies:

<u>Rules</u>	Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf, as modified by the Local Rules The Local Rules Sheet is provided in your tournament packet
<u>Eligibility</u>	Open to all Amateur golfers (no USGA Handicap required)
<u>Receipt of Entry</u>	Entries will be accepted via email, mail, or in the Pro Shop Payment (\$100 Member, \$150 Public) is due the morning of the event (cash, check, card) Players will receive an email or a phone call from the Pro to confirm their entry
<u>Practice Round</u>	May be used (Monday - Friday) of the Tournament Week
<u>Riding / Walking</u>	Golf carts are included for all competitors; though, you may choose to walk
<u>Score Posting</u>	Competitors are responsible to post their own "Tournament" score in the HCP System
<u>Spectators</u>	Spectators are allowed to ride in carts (with a player) \$18 Spectator Fee Golf Carts may be rented to watch play, if available
<u>Distance-Measuring Devices</u>	In all Lakeview GC competitions, players may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance, as long as it cannot gauge or measure other conditions that might affect a player's play (e.g. elevation change, wind speed, etc.) Use of a rangefinder with SLOPE technology is a breach of Rule 14-3
<u>Cell Phone Policy</u>	Cell phones may be used as distance-measuring devices, but must comply with 14-3. Talking on cell phones is prohibited, unless it is for an emergency. Violation of this policy will result in a warning, while continued violation shall result in a disqualification

2020 Pace of Play Policy

Timing

When a group is being timed, each player in the group is expected to play all strokes within 40 seconds. Timing begins when it is the player's turn to play and nothing is obstructing his/her play. An extra 20 seconds will be given to:

- The first player to play a stroke on each hole
- The first to play a second shot on a par 4 or par 5
- The first player to play a 3rd shot on a par 5 (if further than 10 yards)
- The first player to play a stroke from within 10 yards of, or on the putting green

Allotted Time

The allotted time established by the Committee is the maximum amount of time a group should take to complete the play of each hole. This time is adjusted based on the difficulty of the course, travel time between holes, group size and the ability of the field. A normal pace of play should result in completing play under the allotted time.

"Out of Position"

The first group will be considered "out of position" if, at any time during the round, the group takes more than the allotted time as detailed above.

Any following group will be considered "out of position" if it is taking more than the allotted time, and (1) the group reaches a par 3 that is clear of play and all players in the preceding group have played their tee shots on the next hole, or (2) the group reaches a par 4 or par 5 which is clear of play.

Note - A group or player that is clearly playing at a pace that is slower than the other groups in the field may be deemed by the Committee to be "Out of Position", even if the group is within the allotted time.

Communication with a group that is "Out of Position"

Groups will be monitored throughout the round. If a group is "Out of Position", the players in that group may be monitored more closely and timed. Prior to the group being timed, a flag will be placed on the ground between the tee boxes (to let the group know they are "Out of Position" and must get back into position.

A Rules Official will not initiate any verbal contact with any player until a player in a group (with a red flag) has received a bad time... but any player is free to ask a Rules Official about his/her group's pace.

Pace of Play Penalties

First Pace of Play Time Penalty = Warning

A Second Penalty = 1 Stroke Penalty

A Third Penalty = Additional 2 Stroke Penalty (Total of 3 Strokes)

A Fourth Penalty = Disqualification

**Rules or
Other Incidents**

If a ruling, or some other legitimate delay occurs which causes the group in question to lose its position, that group is expected to regain its position in a reasonable time



Welcome

Welcome to the 2020 Lakeview Amateur Championship. This is a 36-hole Stroke Play tournament, with each division (Men's, Senior and Super Senior) being flighted after the completion of Saturday's 1st round.

USGA Rules apply

All USGA Rules apply, as well as the Local Rules sheet that has been provided for you.

Note - If you have any questions as you compete today, please refer to the Pro's cell phone number (on the bottom of your pin sheet). He will come to you. Feel free to text him your name, and where you are on the course, as he may not be able to answer the phone right away without interrupting play.

Local Rules

You may move ball one scorecard length in your own fairway.

You may remove stones in bunkers. (No Penalty). We will rake and place in all bunkers (must place ball where your ball previously was)

There is no penalty for a resting ball which is accidentally moved on the putting green.

The "Embedded Ball" rule is in effect "through the green"-- meaning, anywhere on the Golf Course except in a hazard.

Wood chips, rocks, and mulch will be played as "loose impediments".

You may use rangefinders (with the Slope function **off**)

Rules Reminders

The "1-ball rule" is in effect, meaning you have to play the same type of ball the entire round and may not switch at any point. (Ex:) If you are playing a Titleist Pro V1, you can't even switch to a Titleist ProV1x.

Please take a moment and identify your golf balls to your playing partners.

A friendly reminder to make sure that you only have 14 clubs in your bag to start.

Please note the "Pace of Play" guidelines (on your scorecard, above each hole). The Pro will be monitoring this throughout the day. If you stay within 1 hole of the group in front of you, you're doing well.

Ground Under Repair has been marked as best as possible. It was primarily marked to protect the player from injury and clubs from damage, due to striking rocks or roots

during the golf swing. However this is not meant to apply to a ball simply laying on hard pan. Local rule: it is realized that there will be areas of rocks and roots that have NOT been marked as ground under repair- but the player feels that a rock or root impairs the golf swing the player may request relief from the player's competitors in that group (playing it as ground under repair). The player is entitled to relief if it is shown that the rock or root interferes with the swing. If the group can not come to a consensus (to whether relief is warranted or where that relief would be)-then a member of the rules committee should be called to final ruling.

The Out of Bounds is defined with a white line or stakes in all areas of the course. Lake #2 Tee ball only use white line for out of bounds. Some holes will have large white circle indicating a white out of bounds stake.

(Red) Lateral Hazards are marked on the sides of **many** holes. The red stakes identify the hazard and the red lines define the margins of the hazard.

You may not play a "provisional ball" for a ball that could be lost in a water hazard. The (Red) Lateral Hazards are marked on Peak (left of # 2, left and right of # 3, right of # 4, and right of # 5)... as well as on Mountain (right of # 1, left of # 4, right of # 5, right of # 8 and right of # 9)

Play the ball as it lies throughout the **entire** tournament, as per USGA Rules are in effect. (Except in your own fairway, you may move one scorecard length.)

Tees

The Championship Division will play from the Blue Tee markers.

The Men's Division will play from the White Tee markers.

The Senior (55 - 69 year old) Division will play from the Gold Tee markers.

The Super Senior (70 and older) Division will play from the Green Tee markers.

Scorecards

Please keep one of your playing partner's scores, as well as your own on the "Marker" line of your scorecard, so you can check your scores and sign your cards before turning them into the scoring pavilion after play

Cart Rules

The cart rule today is 90 degrees.

Please do not drive through the Ground Under Repair.

Also, please keep your carts on the path by all tees and on all par 3's

Flights

The lowest scores in **All** Divisions will qualify for the Championship Flight.

Ties (for Championship slots) will be determined by a sudden death playoff.

The Winner, Runner-up and 3rd place contestant will win Golf Shop Gift Cards.

Food and Bev

Lastly a reminder about taking care of yourself today: it will be **very hot**

- We are starting you off with a cold bottle of water (Reminder there is no water on the Course. Please, make sure you have plenty of water!)

- You will be provided a box lunch each day. (You can get at the turn or the end of your round)
