

Thank you for your interest in the 2025 Lakeview Club Championship.

Saturday's 1st Round will be played on Peak - Mountain. Sunday's 2nd Round will be played on Mountain - Lake.

There are 4 divisions: Men's, Women's, Senior, and Super Senior

To play in the Men's Division (regardless of age), you must play the Blue tees.

To play in the <u>Senior Division</u>, you must be 55 to 69 years of age, from the Gold tees.

To play in the Super Senior Division, you must be 70 years of age (or older), from the Red tees.

To play in the Women's Division, you must play from the Green tees.

Attention will be paid to weather conditions as the event nears, when considering the course setup. The Golf Pro will set up the golf course each day, as tee and pin locations will be different each day.

After Saturday's 1st Round of competition, each division will be flighted according to score. The lowest scores in each division will qualify for the Championship Flight.

All other competitors (in each division respectively) will then be separated into the 1st Flight, 2nd Flight, etc. The # of players paid in each flight will depend on the total # of players in each division.

There will be an OPTIONAL \$KINS game both days (\$10 per day)

To all participants in The 2025 Lakeview Club Championship:

Rules Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf, as modified by the Local Rules

The Local Rules are mentioned in your tournament packet

Eligibility Open to all Lakeview Members / Employees

(no USGA Handicap required)

Receipt of Entry Entries will be accepted in the Golf Shop

Riding / Walking Golf carts are included for all competitors, though you may choose to walk

<u>Distance-</u> <u>Measuring</u> Devices In all Lakeview GC competitions, players may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance, as long as it cannot gauge or measure other conditions

that might affect a player's play (e.g. elevation change, wind speed, etc.)

Use of a rangefinder with SLOPE technology is a breach of Rule 14-3

<u>Cell Phone</u> Policy

Cell phones may be used as distance-measuring devices, but must comply with 14-3. Talking on cell phones is prohibited, unless it is for an emergency.

Violation of this policy will result in a warning, while continued violation shall result in a disqualification

Welcome

Welcome to The 2025 Lakeview Club Championship.

This is 36-Hole Stroke Play, with three divisions (Men's, Senior and Super Senior). Each division will be flighted after the completion of Saturday's 1st round.

USGA Rules apply

All USGA Rules apply, as well as the Local Rules below.

Note - If you have any questions as you compete today, please refer to the Pro's cell phone number (on the bottom of your pinu sheet). He will come to you. Feel free to text him your name, and where you are on the course, as he may not be able to answer the phone right away without interrupting play. If he cannot get to you in a timely manner, then play 2 balls and we'll figure it out at the completion of your round.

Local Rules

You may remove stones in bunkers. You may rake and place ball in same spot in bunker (no penalty)

You may roll the ball in your own fairway 1 scorecard length.

There is no penalty for a resting ball which is accidentally moved on the putting green.

The "Embedded Ball" rule is in effect "through the green", meaning anywhere on the golf course except in a hazard.

Wood chips and mulch are to be played as "loose impediments".

You may use rangefinders (but not with the slope function turned on).

All roots and rocks are played as ground under repair.

Rules Reminders

Please take a moment and identify your golf balls to your playing partners.

A friendly reminder to make sure that you only have 14 clubs in your bag to start.

Please note the "Pace of Play" guidelines (on your scorecard, above each hole). The pro will be monitoring this throughout the day. If you stay within 1 hole of the group in front of you, you're doing well.

Ground Under Repair is marked with white lines on the golf course (and sometimes identified by the letters GUR). If your ball ends up in the GUR, you cannot play it from there and must take your nearest point of relief. Take your nearest possible, playable stance... mark the position of the clubhead (in your setup to hit the ball) with a tee. Drop the ball (without penalty) within 1 club length of the tee, no closer to the hole.

The Out of Bounds is defined white stakes or white line in all areas of the course x



(Red) Lateral Hazards are marked on the sides of many holes. The red stakes identify the hazard and the red lines define the margins of the hazard.

You may not play a "provisional ball" for a ball that could be lost in a water hazard. The (Red) Lateral Hazards are marked on Peak (left of # 2, left and right of # 3, right of # 4, and right of # 5)... as well as on Mountain (right of # 1, left of # 4, right of # 5, right of # 8 and right of # 9)

Play the ball it lies, you may roll the ball one scorecard in your own fairway.

<u>Tees</u> The Men's Division will play from the Blue tee markers.

The Senior (50 - 65 years old) Division will play from the Gold tee markers. The Super Senior (66 and older) Division will play from the Red tee markers.

<u>Scorecards</u> Competitors are responsible for posting playing partners' scores in the lakeview APP.

<u>Cart Rules</u> The cart rule is 90 degrees.

Please do not drive through the Ground Under Repair.

Also, please keep your carts on the path by all tees and on all par 3's

<u>Flights</u> The lowest scores in the Men's Division will qualify for the Championship Flight.

Tie's (for Championship slots) will be determined by a playoff.

Winners will receive Golf Shop gift cards.

The lowest scores in the Senior Division will qualify for the Championship Flight.

Tie's (for Championship slots) will be determined by a playoff.

Winners will receive Golf Shop gift cards.

The lowest scores in the Super Senior Division will qualify for the Championship Flight.

Tie's (for Championship slots) will be determined by a playoff.

Winners will receive Golf Shop gift cards.

<u>Playoff</u> All championship flights will have a playoff after everyone has completed regular play.

(Starting on Lake #1). All other flights will have a scorecard playoff.

Sandbag Rule All players who shoot 10 shots better than Day 1 will automatically be moved up a flight.
